

# Road & Trail Map



## Overview

"Something for everyone" is the best way to describe the over twenty-five miles of designated hiking and mountain biking trails on Beech Mountain. Enjoy an easy stroll through the woods, a brisk hike to sweeping vistas, or speed down an exhilarating, winding bike trail along Beech's highest ridge. There is also a one-quarter mile paved handicap-accessible trail around Lake Coffey, a one-third mile walking track around Buckeye Rec. Center and a paved greenway in the heart of town.

## Ways to Explore

Our trails are perfect for seasonal activities such as bird-watching. With over 137 species across the mountain, Beech is part of the official NC Birding Trails. Grosbeaks, Owls, Warblers, Woodpeckers, Hawks and Cardinals are just some of the birds you'll see in our area. Some of the trails are NC Wildlife hatchery supported so you can trout fish along your hike.

## Safety and Etiquette

Hikers and bikers are urged to stay on the designated trails. Trail users should inform someone about trail exploration plans, and when they should be expected back. Water along the trails is not potable. Some trails are remote and away from populated areas. Others follow undeveloped roadways, and several follow some of the Town's roads. Hikers must be cautious of traffic and be aware of the type of trail they have chosen. Being prepared by wearing proper clothing and footwear, dressing in layers, and watching out for wildlife are recommended precautions when hiking or biking Beech Mountain's trails. Camping and campfires are not allowed on any trail. Many trails cross private land; respect private property and stay on the marked trail. Carry out all litter, including food and pet waste.

## Mountain Biking

Many of the hiking trails are compatible with mountain biking. When on the trails that are both for hiking and riding, please exercise caution. Some of the roads in the outlying areas are great for riding. Please do not ride on trails designated for hiking only. To avoid damaging newly constructed trails and to help maintain the trail system, please do not ride on rain-soaked trails or trails that have been closed due to maintenance or weather.

## Picnicking

Picnic tables can be found at various parks and other locations throughout the mountain. There are picnic shelters at the Bark Park, the Greenway, Perry Park, and one which overlooks Buckeye Lake (this shelter requires reservations which can be made through the Buckeye Recreation Center, please call 828-387-3003).

## Pets

Dogs are welcome on all trails on our pet friendly mountain. Leashes are required for the safety of your pet and our wildlife. Dogs are allowed off-leash in the fenced-in area of the Town's Bark Park, located at the top of the hill behind the Brick Oven Pizzeria. Please clean up after your pet at the dog park and on trails.



## (A) Buckeye Lake Loop – 1.6 miles

A great woodland trail around Buckeye Lake, which is considered a bird watching hot spot by the High Country Audubon Society. The trail links hikers and bikers to the Falls Trail and the Buckeye Recreation Center. Easy to Moderate. Hiking and Biking.

## (B) Falls Trail – 1 mile

Located by Buckeye Recreation Center, this is a great 1-mile loop to a wonderful waterfall. You may fish the stocked stream as well. This trail links with the Buckeye Lake Loop. Easy to Moderate. Hiking only.

## (C) Sassafras – 1 mile

An old roadbed that is perfect for a pleasant walk on Beech Mountain without navigating roots and rocks. For a longer hike, you can connect to Grassy Gap Creek. Easy. Hiking and Biking.

## (D) Grassy Gap Creek – 2.2 miles

A favorite for mountain bikers and hikers, this woodland trail follows Grassy Gap downhill to Pine Ridge Road, near the Buckeye Recreation Center. It is rugged and provides great mountain scenery. There are a few gravel road crossings, so watch for trail signs. Moderate. Hiking and Biking.

## (E) Hickory Spur – .4 mile

Switch back through the trees from S. Hickory Lane. This woodland trail connects to Owl Prowl, which in turn connects to Grassy Gap Creek for a longer hike. Easy. Hiking and biking.

## (F) Owl Prowl – 1.2 mile

Given its name due to the many Owls that can be seen and heard along its route, it winds its way through the mountainside providing a gradual walk and exciting ride for bikers. It can be accessed from Grassy Gap Creek (Hawthorne Rd. trailhead) or from Hickory Spur (S. Hickory Lane trailhead). Easy. Hiking and biking.

## (G) Wild Iris – 1.7 mile

Open trail, full of wildflowers and butterflies in the summer. The path follows old roadbeds through the lush forests of Beech Mountain. See if you can find the small cave on the trail. Easy to Moderate. Hiking, Biking, Skiing, and Snowshoeing.

## (H) Redfox – 1.5 miles

This trail follows a gravelled Town road. Extend your hike by linking to the upper portion of Grassy Gap to Pine Ridge Road and the Buckeye Recreation Center or the lower portion to Hawthorn Road. Easy to Moderate. Hiking, Biking, Skiing, and Snowshoeing.

## (I) Smoketree – 1.8 miles

A nice grassy trail with a hidden treasure of a series of small waterfalls. The woodland path runs from the trailhead at Mill Pond Lane past town limits to the Beech Mountain Parkway Extension. Easy to Moderate. Hiking, Biking, Skiing, and Snowshoeing.

## (J) Westerly Hills – 4.5 miles

This trail is great for snowshoeing, XC running and skiing. You will be immersed in the forest with nothing but the sounds of birds and the trees.

## (K) Overlook Trail – .4 miles

The trail connects Perry Park to the Overlook off the Beech Mountain Pkwy. This is a great way to extend your hike from the center of town and enjoy one of the best long range views on the Mountain. Moderate. Hiking only.

## (L) Forked Trail – .4 miles

This short trail starts open and turns woodland before heading down a gravel road behind the inns. It's part of a hiking path from the business district to Perry Park via a network of connecting trails. Take the Greenway to the Forked Trail and then link to the Overlook Trail to Perry Park. Easy. Hiking only.

## Emerald Outback Trail System

This well-marked trail system is located at the top of Beech Mountain, accessible from North Pinnacle Ridge Road. **Note: Trailhead can not be accessed from Skilift Road.**

Enter the trails on **Og Forest Run** (1.1 mi, Easy) through the forest of Beech trees for which the mountain is named. An overlook with a broad view to the west is located about 3/4 of a mile in. Shortly after the trail head, **Toto's Trot** (.3 mi, Easy) can be accessed. A short, flat, wide trail. For mountain bikers, this is a very beginner friendly trail with one fun challenge in the middle. At the 1.1 mile point along Og Forest Run, two other trails are accessed. **Wigard's Way** (.3 mi, Easy to Moderate) leads back down to Og Forest Run and **Southern Ridge** (.93 mi, Moderate to Strenuous), which connects to **Ruby Slippers** (.32 mi, Moderate to Strenuous, BIKE ONLY) and leads to three overlooks to the east and northeast. Bikers will love **Witch's Backbone** and **Witch's Tail** (.5/3 mi, Strenuous, BIKE ONLY). Witch's Backbone leads to the **Grassy Road Loop** (1 mi, Moderate), and **Northview** (1 mi, Easy). Also leading off **Grassy Road Loop** is **Jackalope's** (1.34 mi, Easy), which connects back to Wigard's Way.

Choose to walk or bike all or part of this system, as the ten interconnected trails are designed to provide a variety of hiking and biking experiences.
