Visitor Usage and Programming Highlights

There were a total of 1,604 daily visits to the Recreation Center for the month of April 2011. Sixty seven (67) passes were sold/renewed in April 2011. There were seven (7) resident individual passes, fifty one (51) resident family passes, one (1) nonresident individual passes, three (3) personal training passes, and zero (0) tennis ball machine passes sold for the month of April 2011.

During the month of April the Buckeye Recreation Center held various fitness classes and recreation programs. The Buckeye Recreation Center hosted a very successful Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, April 23, 2011.
